

The Challenge



The burden of rote learning weighs heavily on young minds, especially when they are asked to memorize multiplication tables in primary classes. Despite the best efforts of teachers, many students struggle to commit these tables to memory, leading to a cycle of frustration and stress.








The Change

The children developed a habit to learn table with fun from the first standard.

“After introducing the tables each day, the students are able to learn the tables and they didn’t have to rote learn it.”



Project Steps

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1. The principal noticed that the students didn't enjoy learning tables as it was a tedious act.
 2. The principal sat with the team and discussed what they could do that learning tables would be fun for students.
 3. The strategy planned was to use the calendar dates to learn the tables. For example, Today is the 27th, so all the grade students will learn 27 table.
 4. This happens daily for 10-15 minutes, before beginning the session.
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
