Due to this children are regularly coming to the Anganwadi and the number of children has also increased. Earlier the number of children was forty, which has now increased to above sixty.

Project Steps

- 1. When the parents used to come to the Anganwadi to drop and pick up the children, they saw that very different things started happening in the Anganwadi centre.
- 2. The classroom of the Anganwadi Centre is beautiful and attractive to the children. They see following things:
 - a. They are now treated with love.
 - b. They are welcomed with greetings.
 - c. A story is told to them and read aloud is incorporated.
 - d. They are given a chance to play.
 - e. They learn through playing games.
- Parents saw all these things and started talking with the workers and LECIN facilitators about the changes.
- 4. They are sharing with other people that Sirsa's Anganwadi has now become very good, and they can also get their children enrolled.
- 5. In this way the number of children has increased and new enrollments are being done.
